Members Approve Amendment to NCC Articles of Incorporation

New Center Council (NCC) members, board, and staff met at Il Centro Ristorante in November to hear a brief update of NCC and community initiatives, as well as to vote to amend the organization's articles of incorporation and by-laws to more closely reflect its current operations.

Henry Ford Hospital CEO, Steve Velick chaired the meeting at which the proposed changes were approved by the membership. The amendment to NCC's articles of incorporation will allow for the future establishment of a wholly-owned, for-profit development corporation which will act on behalf of the Council to facilitate key components of the New Center Economic Development Plan.

NCC staffers concluded the meeting with brief reports about economic development activities, public space maintenance, youth and charitable programs, and this year's Comerica Michigan TasteFest. Members and staff stayed on to celebrate New Center's progress and discuss current and upcoming projects that will ensure a bright future for the area – all accompanied by musical entertainment and hors d'oeuvres.
